<p><b>ADEYINKA</b> <b>Toyin</b></p>	<p>Mother of a nearly 3 year old, an active member of the 'buggy army' last year, went on the marches, attended a number of Campaign meetings and demonstrated against Clause 118. Am keen to get more involved in the SLH Campaign and fight against cuts and privatisation of the NHS.</p>
<p><b>BACCHUS</b> <b>Tamsin</b></p>	<p>Law background, work for Lewisham Pensioners Forum (so co-ordinating campaign storage and some printing); work contacts throughout Borough; involved in merchandise, anti-marketisation, section 75 work and Monitor letter; occasional Brockley Market stall. No mainstream political affiliations – generally vote Green in protest against everyone. Now a member of the NHAP.</p>

Also involved with event planning and comms across a wide range of activities for the campaign. Policy and press background. Patient advocate. Disability officer. SnrAssoc RSM; MRSPH; Chair London Socialist Health Assoc.</p>
<p><b>BROWN</b> <b>Carol</b></p>	<p>I would not be here without Lewisham. I was determined to save it. I have helped promote the campaign on social media and made links with other campaigns. The Government’s plan to close ICUs when ‘downgrading’ A&amp;Es must be publicised. I am joining the Intensive Care Society with this in mind.</p>
<p><b>COYNE</b> <b>Cheryl</b></p>	<p>The NHS - civilisation’s real wealth - is threatened by Governments’ privatisation, by PFI, and the EU:USA Trade Treaty. As an existing SC member who’s played a full part in the campaign, and a believer in People before Profit, I want the local success to become a national norm.</p>

Active participant in building campaign demonstrations, particularly our delegation to the national demonstration in Manchester.
